

## **Self-Screening prior to Attending Work**

**To keep the people we support and co-workers safe I am asking all employees to do this Self-Screening prior to attending work.**

Do you have any of the following symptoms fever/feverish, new or existing cough and difficulty breathing? (Note: not at chronic cough such as asthma, seasonal allergies ect..)

Have you traveled internationally withing the last 14 days (outside of Canada)?

Have you had close contact with a confirmed or probable COVID-19 case?

Have you had close contact with a person with acute respiratory illness who has been outside Canada in the last 14 days?

If the employee answers no to all the questions above, they have passed the screening and can go to work.

If the employee answers yes to any of the screening questions they cannot go to work and must contact their manager for further direction and screening by Nicole Morassut, Director, Human Resources.

If employees are showing symptoms of illness that are not COVID-19 related they should be staying home until they are symptom free.
