

The Great Zoom "NETspectations"

What are NETspectations?

"NET" is from the word *Internet* and "*spectations*" is from *Expectations*.

They are rules and tips for you to follow to help make Zoom activities fun and safe for everyone.

Setting Up for the Activity

- **Find a space in your home where you can enjoy** the activity.
 - If you need space to move, find a spot in your home where you can.
 - If you need to focus for an activity, try to find a spot that is quiet.
 - Make sure that there is enough light for you to see the activity and be seen (if you choose).
- **Make sure you are prepared for the activity.** For example, the speakers are on or any activity materials are ready for you.
- **If you would like a bigger screen,** try connecting your computer to display on your TV.



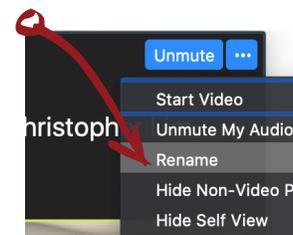
Respect and Privacy

- **Respect privacy of yourself and others.** Please do not share private information about yourself in a group, or any private information about others. If they cannot share their information themselves, it is not yours to share for them.
- **People can see and hear you if your camera and microphone are on.** Please do not say or do anything in front of the camera that you would normally do in private.
- **Please wait your turn to speak.** It is important that everyone gets a chance to be heard if they want to talk.
- **You can raise your hand, wave, or send a message** in the chat to let the activity leader know you have something to say.
- **Be kind to one another.** Use respectful language with everyone on the call. Although jokes can be funny to some people, they may be hurtful to others.
- **Please do not take pictures** or screenshots of the group without everyone's permission.



Tech Help!

- **If you are on MUTE, the host cannot UNMUTE you.** Unmute yourself or connect with a friend or supporter that is nearby for help.
- **You can rename yourself** in the Zoom meeting. This can help the activity leader and others to call you by name.
- **Internet or Zoom connection problems can happen.** Try logging off and logging back in to see if that fixes the problem.
